- 1. Go to <http://ProcurementSearch.com>. It's free, and you don't need to register.**
2. Type in your search term, e.g.: *plumbing* or *"landscape architecture"*

- 4. View details on any listing, contracting opportunity, or RFP — find out next steps, who you can call with questions, and more information about the agency.**

TIPS FOR USE:

Use quotes to match a complete phrase if you're getting too many results.

Refine your search results with filters — you can limit to a few agencies, sort by relevance vs due date, and more.

Do historical prospecting by searching for closed contracts, not just open ones.
